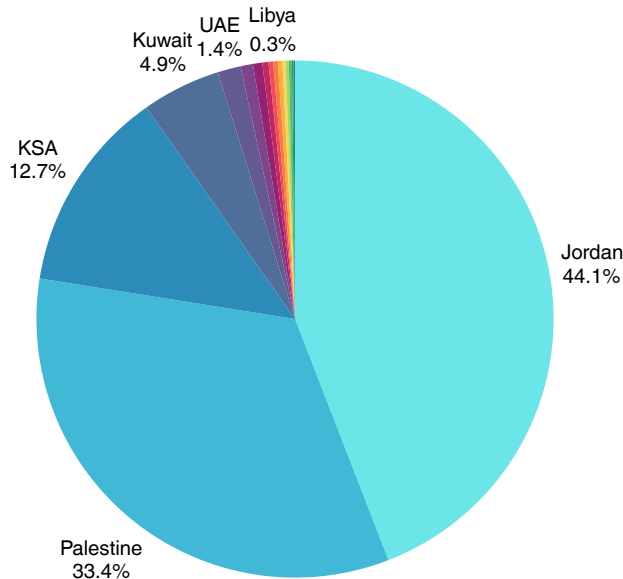

Course Overview

Childhood Apraxia of Speech (CAS)

This course focuses on understanding Childhood Apraxia of Speech and distinguishing it from other speech sound disorders.

The course covers the core cognitive skills related to this disorder, principles of motor planning, assessment techniques, and early identification in toddlers and preschool-aged children.

Participants will learn how to use appropriate assessment tools, build a comprehensive diagnostic profile, and develop individualized treatment plans.

The course also includes evidence-based therapy programs and strategies for children with limited speech abilities, promotes multimodal communication, and supports the development of speech and language in early childhood, while preparing therapists to respond to common caregiver questions regarding expectations and treatment outcomes.

Course Objectives

Foundation and Understanding of CAS

- Define and explain the neurological basis of CAS.
- Understand the motor planning and programming disorders and characteristics of CAS.
- Review the main theoretical perspectives related to CAS.
- Identify common speech and language challenges observed in children with CAS.
- Discover early signs of CAS in toddlers and preschool-aged children.

Assessment of CAS

- Understand the goals of CAS assessment, including identifying motor speech deficits and differentiating CAS from other speech disorders.
- Familiarize with standardized and non-standardized tools used in CAS evaluation.
- Analyzing test results to identify the hallmark features of CAS.
- Develop a case profile based on assessment findings.
- Learn to differentiate CAS from phonological disorders and dysarthria.



Course Objectives

Treatment of CAS

- Understand the principles of effective CAS treatment.
- Review evidence-based treatments such as DTTC, PROMPT therapy, etc.
- Learn to apply the principles of motor learning theory in the treatment of CAS.
- Explore research and clinical guidelines that support various treatment.
- Learn how to create individualized treatment plans for children with CAS.

Treatment for Minimally Verbal Children

- Understand the challenges faced by minimally verbal children.
- Explore techniques for initiating therapy with minimal verbal children.
- Introduce strategies for building early speech and language skills.
- Prepare to answer common questions from parents and caregivers about prognosis, treatment outcomes, and long-term expectations for children with CAS and minimal verbal output.

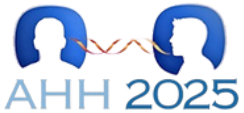
