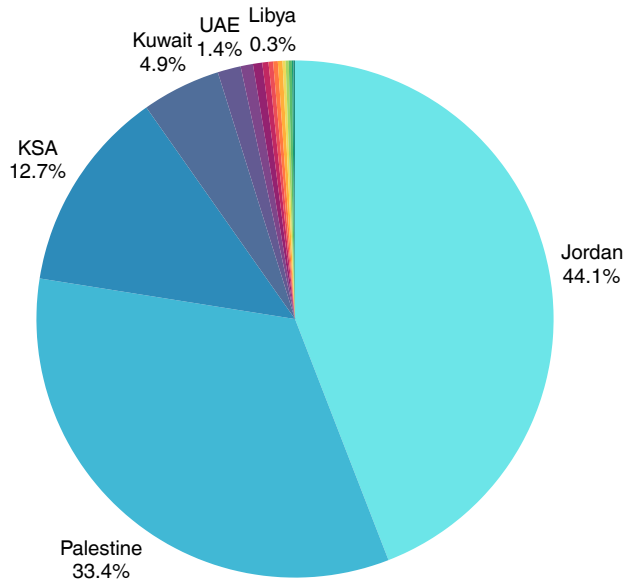

Gestalt Language Processing

This course introduces Gestalt Language Processing (GLP), a natural and meaningful way some individuals acquire language. Participants will learn how GLP differs from Analytic Language Processing (ALP), explore the stages of Natural Language Acquisition (NLA), and review key research on echolalia, scripting, and language development. The course also covers how to identify and assess Gestalt language processors, interpret speech samples, and apply evidence-based strategies to support children as they progress through the GLP stages toward self-generated, flexible language.

Course Objectives

1- Understand Gestalt Language Processing (GLP):

- Define GLP and distinguish it from Analytic Language Processing (ALP).
- Explain the Natural Language Acquisition (NLA) framework and its stages.
- Analyze Research and Developmental Patterns:
- Summarize key research on echolalia, scripting, and language acquisition.
- Recognize the role of immediate and delayed echolalia in language development.

2- Identify and Assess Gestalt Language Processors:

- Describe the six stages of GLP and their speech characteristics.
- Differentiate between Gestalt and Analytic processors through speech analysis.

3- Apply Clinical Knowledge to Support Language Development:

- Use appropriate strategies to facilitate progression through GLP stages.

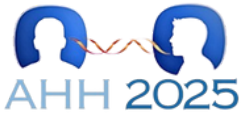
